### Position Purpose

The Research Officer will support the Director Knowledge Management in the research, monitoring and evaluation functions of CMID. He/she will lead on the ground research and documentation activities of CMID. The roles include development of concept notes/proposals, preparation of data collection tools/software, preparation of databases, undertaking analysis of data and the preparation of the reports,

human interest stories, policy briefs. He/she should be willing to travel extensively in southern India. Last date for application is January 05, 2026.

### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Support the Director in the knowledge management function
- Undertake desk research and secondary data analysis
- Prepare research tools/software using web/mobile based applications
- Support training and mentoring of field staff
- Undertake quantitative and qualitative primary research and data analysis
- Preparation and dissemination of technical papers, case studies, human interest stories and other relevant documents
- Analysis of programme and research data and development of dashboards and reports
- Prepare the periodic reports/MIS to various donors and other stakeholders
- Undertake other relevant tasks as assigned by the supervisor

### **Qualification and Experience**

PhD/MPhil in Social Sciences with at least one year of experience in qualitative and quantitative research. Candidates with post-graduation and relevance experience will also be considered. The candidate should be well-versed in at least one each of the qualitative and quantitative research and data analysis software. He/she would also be an expert in web/app based data collection. Candidates with prior experience in conducting scoping reviews will be preferred. Experience in thematic areas of gender and labour migration research is desirable. A thorough understanding of labour migration related issues in India will be an added advantage. Knowledge of Hindi and one other major language spoken by migrants, such as Bengali, Assamese, Odia, Tamil, etc. is desirable. The person should possess good skills in data analysis and preparation of research reports.
